We are accepting applications for the 2023 AHEPA District 21 Scholarship Program.

2023 AHEPA District 21 Scholarship Program

This program is available to members in good standing of the Order of AHEPA or Daughters of Penelope, for a minimum of two (2) consecutive years, (a member in good standing is described in the Constitution and By-Laws of the AHEPA or Daughters of Penelope), or current members in good standing of the Sons of Pericles or Maids of Athena, Children of AHEPA and Daughters of Penelope members and under certain conditions, orphans of AHEPA and Daughters of Penelope members. A detailed and more complete list of eligibility requirements is provided on the first page of the application packet.

To be eligible for consideration, your application needs to be complete, endorsed and signed by your local sponsoring AHEPA or Daughters of Penelope Chapter President (or a designated Chapter Scholarship Chairperson) and the Chapter Secretary. Two letters of recommendation and most current transcripts are to be mailed with the scholarship application. Please note: Most high schools and colleges receive a high volume of requests for transcripts and letters of recommendation during the spring months. It is highly recommended that you get your requests to these schools early and follow up to make certain that all materials are mailed before the April 1, 2023 deadline. Late mailing from your school will disqualify your application.

A one-page essay, using 12 pt. font, is required and must be included with your application packet. The essay must focus on your own personal goals, ambitions and commitment to making this a better world for all. You may wish to draw upon the influences of your Hellenic heritage, your parents, your parish and community. If selected, you will be notified by mail.

Our Scholarship Program seeks to recognize outstanding youth within District 21 and their scholastic and community achievements. Support for our scholarship come from AHEPA members and friends of AHEPA who value the importance of higher education. Their tireless efforts have made these scholarship awards possible. We hope that you will consider membership in one of the branches of the AHEPA family and provide your own support to funding scholarships to future students. Above all we encourage you to fully utilize the gifts that God has given you.

The number of awards presented is dependent upon the scholarship funds available for this year. Because of the competition, it is imperative that the application be accurate, neat, complete and submitted on time. Applications which do not meet these requirements will be denied further consideration for approval. The decisions of the Foundation Board and the Independent Evaluator are final. There are no exceptions, extensions or appeals.

A complete checklist is attached. All items on the checklist must be submitted by the deadline date of April 1, 2023. Please include the marked-up checklist with your application.

2023 Scholarship Application**

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Scholarships are offered to qualified applicants each year. The number of Scholarships is dependent upon the funds raised and available each year. Recipients will receive their awards after proof of registration in the college, university or accredited technical school of their choice has been provided to the Chairman of the Educational Foundation.

An Applicant must meet all of the following requirements:

A. Organizational Affiliation:

1. Be a member in good standing of the District 21 Order of AHEPA or Daughters of Penelope, for a minimum of two (2) consecutive years (A member in good standing is as defined in the Constitution and By-Laws of the AHEPA or Daughters of Penelope), or current members in good standing of the Sons of Pericles or Maids of Athena,

OR

2. Be a child of a District 21 AHEPAN or Daughters of Penelope who has been in good standing for a minimum of two (2) consecutive years at the time of submitting their application,

OR

3. The children of a deceased District 21 AHEPAN who has been a member for thirty-six (36) consecutive months prior to death are eligible to apply for this scholarship. If death occurs at any time within the last twelve (12) months of the deceased AHEPAN'S membership, the applicant is considered eligible.

OR

4. Be a current member of the District 21 Sons of Pericles or Maids of Athena.

B. Residency Requirements:

1. The applicant must be a resident of AHEPA Golden Gate District 21. This includes local residents who are attending college away from home.

C. Verification and Endorsement:

1. The application must be verified and endorsed by the local AHEPA Chapter President or AHEPA Chapter Scholarship Chairman) and the AHEPA Chapter Secretary.

Or

2. The application must be verified and endorsed by the local Daughters of Penelope Chapter President (or a designated Daughters of Penelope Chapter Scholarship Chairman) and the Daughters of Penelope Chapter Secretary.

D. Grade Point Average:

1. **UNDERGRADUATE APPLICANT**

- a. Exhibit scholastic excellence in High School, College Prep School or Accredited Technical School maintaining a 3.0 GPA **OR** has attended a college or university full time for one (1) year maintaining a 3.0 GPA.
- b. Provide evidence of leadership qualities, church participation and community service.

2. **GRADUATE APPLICANT**

- a. Exhibit scholastic excellence and maintain a minimum of a 3.0 GPA.
- b. Provide evidence of leadership qualities, church participation and community service.

E. Previous Recipient:

1. Undergraduate Student applicants are eligible to receive two (2) lifetime Undergraduate AHEPA District 21 Scholarship Awards.
2. Graduate Student applicants are eligible to receive one (1) lifetime Graduate AHEPA District 21 Scholarship Award, regardless of having received an Undergraduate Award or not.

F. Board review and Announcement:

The Educational Evaluator is solely responsible for the evaluation of all eligible applicants. Eligibility is at the final discretion of the Educational Foundation. The Educational Foundation will announce the results in writing no later than May 15.

5. **A ONE-page essay** using 12 pt. font describing your goals and ambitions.
6. If additional space is needed on application sections write "Continued" and attach additional sheet(s).
