RAFFLE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Please assign one member of your Chapter to gather ticket stubs and money. This is usually the Chapter Treasurer.
- 2. Checks (payable to Daughters of Penelope District 21) and cash are acceptable forms of payment.
- 3. If cash is collected, the Chapter Treasurer shall deposit the cash in the Chapter's account and write a check for the equal amount payable to Daughters of Penelope District 21.
- 4. Please keep a log of ticket sales, including ticket number, name of purchaser, address, phone number, and corresponding check number. Also make copies of the ticket stubs and keep with your log.
- 5. Submit the full \$20 per ticket. Do not hold back the rebate amount. All rebates to Chapters will be paid at the District Convention.
- 6. Submit your ticket stubs and payments, and a photocopy of the log to my attention at least on a monthly basis. Final ticket stub and payment submission deadline is May 22, 2015.
- 7. Send ticket stubs and payment by Certified Mail with Return Receipt. Alternatively, you can give them to me in person.
- 8. If you need more tickets than the amount initially distributed to your Chapter, please contact me.
- 9. Any unsold tickets must be returned to me by May 22, 2015. Chapters will be responsible for payment of tickets that are not returned.
- 10. Sell, Sell, Sell! Every ticket sold is a win for the District and for your Chapter! Be creative. Beyond friends and family, sell them to your office associates, hairdresser, manicurist, dog groomer and anyone you can! With every sale you make, the next one gets easier.
